A **Tabernacle NC Missions Offering** envelope is in your August envelope packet and available in the vestibule. The NC WMU and NC Baptist Retirement Homes receive NO support through the Baptist State Convention. Distribution is as follows:

- ◆ NC WMU and NC Baptist Men will each receive 33.5% of the offering;
- ◆ NC Baptist Retirement Homes and NC Baptist Children's Homes will each receive 16.5% of the offering.

The rationale is that the NC WMU and NC Baptist Men are largely dependent on support from churches while the retirement and children's homes also receive support through public and private sector grants.
