Biography for Ben and Leonora Newell, Cooperative Baptist Fellowship Missionaries serving in Helena, AR

Ben and Leonora Newell, career field personnel for CBF, are currently serving and ministering in Phillips and Lee Counties, AR., two of the poorest counties in the US. Along with their three children, Lucas (12), Nate (11), and Gabriela (8), the Newells manage a faith-based, non-profit community and economic development ministry.

Ben is a native of Danville, VA; whereas Leonora is from Brazil. Ben has a BA from Hamden-Sydney College in Math and Economics with a MBA degree from The College of William and Mary. Leonora has her BS in Occupational Therapy from an university in Brazil and her Masters in OT from the Medical College of Virginia in Richmond, VA.

They have established a summer mission designation called "All Church Challenge" or ACC where multiple churches from around the country serve alongside local churches and other partners to provide a fun, spirit led, camp for over 350 kids. The ACC 2010 is scheduled for July 10-23 this year and will feature swimming as the main sport activity along with VBS curriculum. The ACC also includes construction, gardening, library, literacy, evangelism, Stories on Wheels mini-camp activities throughout the counties.

A major focus of the Newell's ministry is Business as Mission or BAM. Their initial foray into the Kingdom Business ministry was the establishment of the Delta Jewels co-op in May 2008. These girls and adult mentors have established their own jewelry design and production company that markets and sells around the country. The Delta Jewels ministry provides teenage girls an opportunity to be part of a skills building, morals building, and spiritual understanding mentorship program.

The Newells are currently on Off Field Assignment living in Raleigh, NC, till December 2010.
