Fall Session One: September 8 - October 6 from 6:30—7:30 pm

The 5 Love Languages of Children: Children express and receive love through one of five different communication styles. A parent's love language may be totally different from that of his or her child, which causes hurt feelings and misunderstandings. Join our **Minister of Children, Rev. Esther Parker**, to discover your child's primary language and learn what you can do to effectively convey unconditional feelings of respect, affection, and commitment that will resonate in your child's emotions and behavior. **The cost of the book, which would be good supplemental reading for the class, is \$10.19. or less depending on availability of used copies. This group will meet in Room A12.**

Baptist Diversity — What's in a name? What might it mean to be identified as Baptist? What kinds of Baptists might we be?
