Foods During the Life of Jesus is a study course based on the foods, nourishment, preparation and culture during the life of Christ with examples of Biblical foods and recipes in the Lenten Spirit. Friday, Feb. 4, 6:30 p.m.

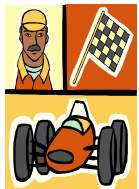
Our Supper Clubs have enjoyed meeting new friends at TBC and finding some interesting places to eat!

Nominating Notes

Thanks to everyone who participated in the Committee Training this past Sunday. We are off to a good start for 2011! If your committee was unable to meet at that time, you are encouraged to meet in order to better understand committee goals and to get to know each other. This can go a long way as decisions are made in the future (one-third of committee members are new each year).

Each year the Church Nominating Committee strives to fill positions necessary for the functioning of Tabernacle (in 2010, Nominating was responsible for filling 101 positions: 15 church officer and program organization leadership positions, 36 committee chair positions, and 50 committee member positions). This was a very task oriented committee, as editing the Committee Guidebook was also an assigned job. Deacon nomination is an additional duty for the committee.

Later in the spring/summer when asked to complete a TBC "census form" indicating your areas of interest for service, please be receptive to turning in a form (there were only 33 forms received in 2010). There are always people who are disappointed in not being placed on a particular committee—however, not everyone can serve on each desired committee as the numbers are prohibitive. Careful consideration and deliberation took place for all assignments. Requests from previous years were also part of this process. Your skills and interests are important to your church; put them to good use! Each person has talents the church needs for the 166 committee positions required each year.

There are currently four committee member positions available: Gardens & Memorials for 2013; Ordinance for 2011; Publicity for 2013; and Youth Council for 2013. If you have interest in any one of these areas and are ready to serve, please contact a Nominating Committee member. There are also vacancies for: Associate Sunday School Director, Associate Discipleship Training Director, and Royal Ambassadors Leader.

A big THANKS to each of you serving in any capacity, as committee decisions and direction are needed to foster growth for our church on the hill!
