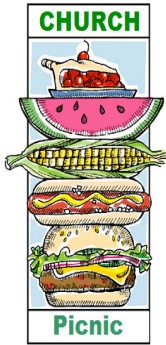

Learn from the Hymns— The Home Bible Study Small Group led by Clyde Smith will begin on Thursday, September 9 at 7:30 p.m. in the home of Carol Jordan (1008 DeBoy St.). The study will be **Learn from the Hymns**, a six study series published by Christian Bible Studies. See Clyde Smith for a study guide (\$2) or for more information. Anyone is welcome to join this small group.

Men of Purpose Bible Study will meet on September 30 at 7 p.m.—This Men's Bible Study meets on the last Thursday of each month in room A20 - 21. All men are invited to participate. **Men in the Bible: Examples to Live By**, author Don Charles, is the study book. This month—Lesson #5.

Wednesday Small Groups Fall 2010 6:30—7:30 pm
Session One: September 8 - October 6

The 5 Love Languages of Children: Children express and receive love through one of five different communication styles. A parent's love language may be totally different from that of his or her child, which causes hurt feelings and misunderstandings. Join our **Minister of Children, Rev. Esther Parker**, to discover your child's primary language and learn what you can do to effectively convey unconditional feelings of respect, affection, and commitment that will resonate in your child's emotions and behavior. **The cost of the book, which would be good supplemental reading for the class, is \$10.19. or less depending on availability of used copies. This group will meet in Room A12.**

Baptist Diversity— What's in a name? What might it mean to be identified as Baptist? What kinds of Baptists might we be? Using Baptist theologian Fisher Humphreys' book, **The Way We Were** and your own experiences, come and explore the almost dizzying (and perhaps unknown) array of traditions and beliefs which contributed to our theological understandings at the turn of the 21st century. Led by **Rev. Dick Wilson**. (*This group will continue in Session Two*) **The cost of the book to be discussed is \$15.00 or less depending upon availability of used copies.** This group will meet in A14.

The New Art of the Job Search— Looking for a job is not what it used to be. The most current numbers show there are five capable candidates for every open job opportunity. Due to the recent advances in social media, the art of finding a job (or a job finding you) begins with your network of contacts. That said, you need a plan of attack that incorporates your personal marketing plan, your resume, and your "profile" on the internet. This group will include a review of these topics using examples and discussion. Led by **Tim Parker**. This group will meet in the Dining Room.

Tabernacle 101— TBC 101 is a time to learn about the history, ministry and organization of TBC and then to spend some time discussing the book **Spiritual Disciplines with the Church, which will be provided to participants.** Led by **Dr. Wayne Hager**. This group will meet in A16.
