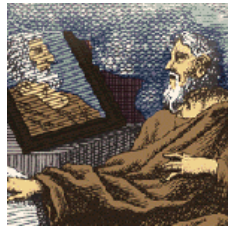

Classes are **FREE**. To register please call the church office, turn in the registration form or email Sarah at sarahmeredithpace@gmail.com.

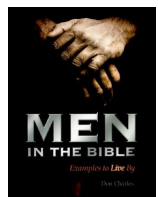
